AMERICAN RED CROSS – EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

(Regarding Death in the Family, Birth, Illness/Injury of an immediate family member to the military member and/or the military member's spouse)**Must meet eligibility requirements: A request can be submitted via the Client Self-Service application when the request is for a military member who is currently on active duty or is activated National Guard/Reserves. To submit your request via the Client Self-Service application, the person involved in the emergency must be an immediate family member of the military member or spouse. This would be the grandparents, parents, children and siblings of the military member and/or the member's spouse.
