**Community-Based Child Care Fee Assistance Program**

The Operation Military Child Care program provides free assistance for families of active duty status in the National Guard, Reserve and Active Duty Service Members. AGR's, Technicians, and/or currently deployed Service Members can apply for a childcare subsidy, which assists in childcare fees for the duration of active duty orders. To qualify, the Service Member's spouse must be working at least 16 hours per week or enrolled in school for at least 6 undergraduate credit hours or three graduate credit hours. Temporary assistance is available for spouses who are seeking employment. All programs require families to use a provider with a state child care license who has been inspected within the last 12 months.
